# BIANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY FOR SALARIED PASTORAL MUSICIANS <br> December, 2008 

## Summary of Results

38 people completed the survey
The average hourly pay for all directors of music ministry working at least 10 hours per week is $\$ 17.81$, equivalent to $\$ 37,044$ for a full-time salary ( 40 hours per week.)

Annual salary ranges for three groups of full-time and regular part-time directors earning at least $\$ 10$ per hour (does not include all respondents):

- 40 hours per week $-\$ 30,000$ to $\$ 51,000$ (10 reporting)
- 30 hours per week - $\$ 30,000$ to $\$ 32,000$ ( 3 reporting)
- 20 hours per week $-\$ 10,000$ to $\$ 20,000$ ( 10 reporting)

As updated in January, 2009, the Archdiocesan Pay Guidelines for Lay Employees recommends the following full-time salary ranges:

- Music Director with Master's Degree
or Music Director/Liturgy Coordinator....\$40,203 to \$60,305 (midpoint, \$50,254)
- Music Director with Bachelor's Degree... $\$ 34,498$ to $\$ 54,822$ (midpoint, $\$ 44,571$ )
- Music Coordinator............................. $\$ 30,206$ to $\$ 45,308$ (midpoint, $\$ 37,757$ )

The exact salary will depend on the particular music minister's qualifications and experience, the scope of the musical, liturgical, and pastoral responsibilities, parish size and setting, and average hours per week.
